WOW! We have so much news of all that has been happening with PUMP Ministries in the last few months. Our God is **GREAT** & we can never thank Him enough. The greatness of His **LOVE** is overwhelming and humbling! Thank **YOU** so much, Father!

God has really been on the move & we are trying to keep up! Let me tell you about the last trip. Richard & Pastor Shawn Jacobson made it to Kenya & were met by Pastor Ibrahim & another PUMP pastor. The first thing they did was buy 18 study Bibles in Nairobi. Richard wanted to get study Bibles that would have things to help teach the pastors. They took off for Kisii to visit with Overseer John from the Pentecostal Assembly of God, Kenya. Richard & Shawn were invited to speak at the Annual Conference for the PAG in the Kisii area.

After this Conference, they traveled to a new area for PUMP Ministries in Northern Kisii. They met Pastor Fetus & enjoyed time with his church.

Then it was time for the PUMP Conference in the Kisii area. When they arrived, they found pastors from Kisii and Tanzania. Pastor Ibrahim, Pastor Shawn & Richard enjoyed handing out the Bibles. They were able to buy 4 more Bibles so each PUMP pastor received one except for one pastor so Richard gave him his own battered study Bible! They were very excited to have their new Bibles! Please keep these pastors in your prayers as they continue to study God's Word & pastor their churches.

Then it was time for a visit to the Orphanage to see the children. Richard just checked on things & visited with the staff that was still there. Most of the children were at school down the road because of our school registration problems. Since Richard came home, we were able to send money for the first & second part of the Government Registration. So the school is back open & the children are able to attend our school! We have one more part of the registration to complete. Pastor Ibrahim does not know the cost for this third part but the first one was \$220 and the second was \$140. There are children that do not live at the Orphanage but attend our school & they are the paying students that pay our staff. We need to build up the attendance again in order to keep our teachers. We were able to send some money to pay the staff while



funds build back up. We also sent money to buy extra food during the harvest time so that we have extra for the harder times. Just like here, food prices increase so we are asking if anyone would like to help increase our food money to \$300 a month? The \$200 a month since we started this adventure is lacking now. Please pray with us for these situations.



The next stop was Mombasa on the coast of the Indian Ocean. They met with Bishop Christopher Ogai Samba, who is the Bishop over 6 churches & Pastor Bayo who is the Bishop over 4 churches. Richard, Pastor Ibrahim and Pastor Shawn had meetings with the leadership to discuss these churches joining PUMP Ministries. While they spoke in the churches, followed by a 2 day Conference, they met Pastor Christopher's wife, Rev. Gladys Ogai. Richard instantly felt a mutual calling with Gladys and Chris. Gladys is now the PUMP Ministries Women's Leader for Eastern Africa & the last contact with Bishop Chris, Gladys is ministering to 40 women! Richard also bought 15 Bibles to hand out there. We want to give a huge **THANK YOU** to all who gave money for the Bibles! What a blessing you are to us & the pastors.

While in Mombasa, Richard, Shawn & Ibrahim took a little time off to go to the ocean. There they met **Mr. Camel!** He was on the beach with his owner. Richard went up to it & the camel was fine but when Shawn & Ibrahim got close to it, it raised up on its hind legs! Ibrahim & Shawn took off, thinking the camel was attacking them! Well, you know it isn't easy to run in the sand so down they both went! Ibrahim kept trying to get Richard to tell it to stop in Spanish because it must not speak Swahili! We all know how well Richard speaks Spanish!The camel was on a lead rope! I wonder if Shawn & Ibrahim will ever go back there!

On October 31 Richard is heading out again for Ghana to minister with Pastor Hayford. He will be holding conferences & other various ministry work. He will be there until Nov. 16 & then he will travel to Najoro, Kenya to work with Overseer Namwuel. He will be doing 3 separate conferences in that area & he heads home on Nov. 28. Several people have expressed an interest in going on this trip. The estimated cost is \$3,200 per person for the whole trip. If you are interested in going your confirmation needs to be in ASAP in order to work on the details here and in Africa. Please pray about going or how you can help with this trip.
