Scriptures for Times of Temptation

In His temptation in the wilderness (Luke 4:1-13), Jesus used Scripture to rebuke Satan's temptation. Also, it tells us in Romans 12:21, "Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good." Scripture helps us in our weak areas and enables us to focus and take control of our thoughts (2 Co. 10:5). You may find your particular struggle in the list below. If not, search the Bible to find a couple of verses that will help. Try to find verses that are not only negative – that is, emphasizing the sin or penalty – but also positive (Phil. 4:8).
